#### **Pastor's Ponderings**

Have you ever made a pledge to church before? If not, I'd like to invite you to join us in making a pledge for 2025. A pledge is a statement of intention whereby you declare your intent to donate a certain amount of money to the church over the course of a fiscal/calendar year. It's a goal you set for yourself to make a voluntary donation — weekly, monthly, quarterly, or yearly. You can change or cancel your pledge at any time. No explanations needed. No questions asked.

In the UCC, we encourage pledging as a way for churches to plan for the upcoming year. It allows us to set the pastor's salary, plan mission projects, provide Christian education, sustain ongoing ministries, do community outreach, maintain the building, pay the utilities, and much more.

In the past ten months, we've received just over \$8,000 in plate offerings and \$6,750 in pledges. If you regularly contribute to the offering on Sundays, it would be helpful if you could make a pledge for those offerings in the coming year, so we can plan our budget more effectively.

You'll be receiving a letter this month that provides more details regarding our budget and financial needs. You'll also receive a pledge card with that letter. Please prayerfully consider what you can contribute to expand the work and mission of Hillcrest Congregational UCC. And please plan to join us on **Sunday, November 24**th, for **Thanks + Giving Sunday** as we celebrate God's gift of "a future with hope."
